Dear School Community,

It is that time of year when we cast our eyes forward and plan for what is ahead. It is an exciting time, but change can always bring with it a level of anxiety and uncertainty. I would like to outline the changes below.

Staffing Arrivals have already been announced but there are also some staff that will be departing next year. I am delighted to announce that current Teacher's Aide Emmily Sowter will be taking up teaching next year at Ardmona Primary School. 'Miss S' as she is otherwise known, has been with us for two years whilst also completing her teaching degree, and I would like to thank her for her dedication to supporting our students and staff. I would also like to congratulate current teacher Carli Neave on her appointment at All Saints in 2026. For those that do not know Mrs Neave was 'borrowed' from her Base School Shepparton East Primary School to look after our Grade 3/4 classroom and has done an amazing job. On behalf of our school community, I thank you both for your contributions to Congupna Primary School and wish you all the best in your future teaching endeavours.

We can also now announce our classroom compositions and teachers for 2026. Mrs Wendy Sidebottom will be in the Grade F/1 and will work closely with new teacher Ms Celeste Huttley in the Grade 1/2 classroom. For the first time in at least the last decade we will operate separate straight Grade 3 and Grade 4 classrooms. *Ms Julia Kildey* will take the Grade 3 classroom, whilst Mr Clark Pettigrew will teach the Grade 4 classroom. Ms Amelia Mangiameli will teach in the senior Grade 5/6 classroom once again. We have collaborated amongst current teachers to find the best balance, considering that two classes (the Grade 3 and 4) will combine for specialist classes so that we can maintain 4 x 1-hour specialist learning blocks throughout a school day. the first time at our **Statewide Transition Day on Tuesday 9**th **December.** I can now confirm that all teachers will be available on this day which is terrific!

Wendy has reported another very positive transition session in the STEM Lab with our ten youngest future students.
