



RESPECTFUL RELATIONSHIPS POLICY

Rationale:

We expect that every child and adult at Congupna Primary School:

- Is respected,
- Knows they deserve respect and
- Shows respect in the way they treat others.

This Policy should be read in conjunction with the School Values Policy as they complement each other to ensure a universally accepted set of values and approach to everything we do at Congupna Primary School.

Aims:

1. To make sure everyone at Congupna Primary School knows that all children will experience the same care and protection from harm regardless of differences between them.
2. To let everyone in the school, our friends and families know that Congupna Primary School protects all children in its community from harm caused by potential exposure from Family Violence.
3. To help anyone take action if they see or hear about someone experiencing harm from violence or experience harm themselves.

Implementation:

This policy should be implemented at all times to help everyone show equal respect for both genders and particularly when:

- We see other people not being respected because they are different in some way, and as if they don't deserve the care and protection other people have,
- We feel like we are not respected because we are different in some way, or don't deserve the care and protection other people have,
- We see that another person is hurt by someone else, and/or
- We are told about harm that has happened to someone, either by the person who has been hurt or by a friend or relative.

Evaluation:

This policy will be reviewed as part of the school's regular review cycle.
