Our ***Creating, Cultivating and Caring at Congupna Kitchen Garden and Nutrition sessions have been amazing*** this Term and our resident expert Katie Thorp has been very ably supported by our School Chaplain Tam Joyce. ***Students will be visited by local artist Tank next week to continue to explore some ways that we can celebrate our program*** and brighten up our school. 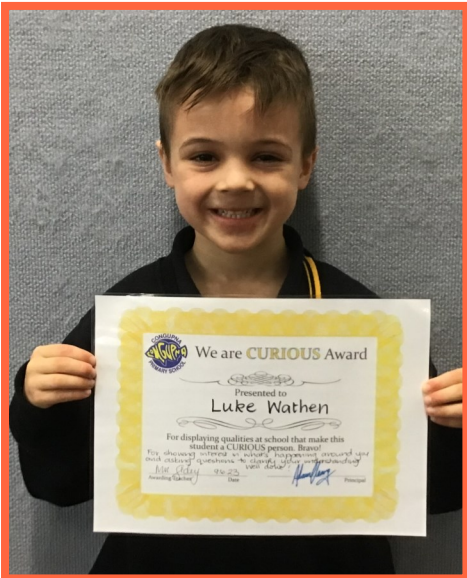

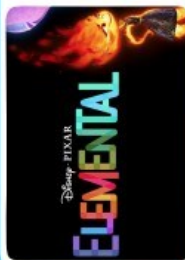
