Dear School Community,

Our **Student Learning Conferences last week were very well attended.** As a school, we privilege and value the time to be able to meet with our families. It is a very big day of back-to-back meetings for teachers, and we appreciate that families must make significant adjustments for the day so thank you.

Our *Grade F-2 students* will be attending a Goulburn Valley Grammar School Matinee *Production of 'Moana'* at Westside in Mooroopna next *Wednesday 9th August*. This excursion is free of charge and will be a great chance for our junior classrooms to 'spread their wings' and critique a terrific production. A 'little birdie' has told me that there may be some school siblings involved too so this should be exciting. Thanks to GVGS for extending this generous invitation.






