Dear School Community,

Our Kitchen Garden Program began last Friday with a big tidy up of our vegetable garden and chook pens. The program continues with Katie Thorp this Friday when students will be participating in a Kitchen session. Students used the outdoor classroom to brainstorm potential recipes and projects to explore for 2024. I can't wait to see what awesome things they create and learn about.

Our Essendon Football Club visit on Monday was terrific. It is great for our students to have the opportunity to see fine examples of athletes who have committed themselves to constant improvement and rigorous effort to achieve excellence in their field. This theory can be applied to anything that our students set their minds to and even if students didn't support the Bombers, it was great to have this level of access to AFL athletes.

All three specialist classes have resumed this week. Students experienced MARC Library and STEM (Science Technology Engineering Mathematics) on Tuesday and LOTE (Language Other Than English) Auslan on Wednesday. Our MARC Library and MACC Art sessions rotate fortnightly on Tuesdays and STEM will move to a Wednesday for the first time on 06/03/24 when Foundation students attend for the full week. Welcome back to Ms Craik (STEM), Ms Foster (LOTE), Mrs Campbell (Library) and Mr Pettigrew (Art).

Our School Swimming Program begins next week. Please return permission forms and money by tomorrow at the latest. We do expect all children to participate, and the primary objective is water safety, not winning Olympic gold medals (but if that happens, that would be nice too). Non-participants will still attend the swimming pool with a book if they are not swimming as nearly all staff will be attending these sessions. Don't forget to bring a plastic bag, spare underwear, towel, swimming goggles if you wear them (optional), a rashie (compulsory) and swimming gear (which should be worn underneath their school uniform). Please label all belongings. Each student will attend half-hour sessions over the six days and will also wait for half an hour at the squash courts (F-2) or Outdoor Pool (3-6) whilst they are not swimming. We have planned to have no

more than six students in a group and have helped to ensure students are grouped according to ability (although some minor changes are always made in the first couple of days).

Our Student Learning Conferences take place next Friday 16th February and you will find a Timetable attached to this Newsletter. If this is not a suitable time, please contact your classroom teacher directly on Seesaw to organise an alternative time on the same day or a different day if required. We have simplified our student learning goals in 2024 to streamline this interview and allow more time for parent/carer conversations. We must follow these times strictly as we have many families moving from classroom to classroom with siblings. If you require more time, please organise a follow-up meeting for another day so we can stay on schedule. This is a student-free day and care will be available for those families that need it with TheirCare.

Please find our Congupna Cruzers Welcome Letter attached. This is our school soccer side and is a terrific way for families and students to socialise and have fun outside of school. 

The Soccer season will be here soon, will you consider playing for the Congupna Cruzers?!

The season will start on: Saturday 20th April (Term 2, 2024)

For parents new to soccer, please consider it for your child's first team sport. It is a great game to introduce them to the fun of playing for your school in a very relaxed and supported environment. The Cruzers support everyone getting a game with the key focus on having lots of fun whilst developing ball skills and good teamwork.

This year we would love to field as many teams as we can. Generally, your child will play with classmates and other children from within our cluster of small schools. This is a great way for them to broaden their friendship group and have fun. All games are held on Saturday in Shepparton at the Sports City Precinct with varying times. There is no soccer over the long weekends or school holidays and no training for the junior teams.
