**Dear School Community,** 

The warm weather has certainly arrived, and students are playing outside with our *school broad-brimmed hats. These are available at Administration* if you require a new one. Each classroom has its own sunscreen that students will be encouraged to apply on high to extreme UV days as per advice from the Cancer Council. If your child has allergies or a preferred sunscreen, please make sure they have some in their bags or at school to use regularly.

We have resumed *streamed numeracy lessons* after our Number Fluency Assessment Tasks were reintroduced this week. We will *complete two of these numeracy lessons a week* after lunch on Mondays and Thursday for eight weeks in total. All students have been assessed and will participate in these maths tasks that are designed to reflect the individual learning need of each student. We will focus on tasks in Addition & Subtraction, Multiplication & Division, Counting & Numeration. *It is great that we can do this in numeracy to complement our streamed CLIM* (Congupna Literacy Instructional Model) focus on literacy as well.

Online Lunch Orders using the Spriggy Schools App went very well last Friday and we have continued to improve the process this week. We are asking you to update your Children's Profiles on the Spriggy Schools App to reflect the correct classroom now that they have all been added (F, 1/2, 2/3, 3/4 & 4/5/6). This will enable the Congupna General Store to deliver a lunch order bag straight to each classroom without us needing to sort them at school. If you do not order on the App, please write your child's name on the bag. Thank you, Nick and Manika, for helping improve our Lunch Order processes at school.

Our Kitchen Garden Program will resume next Friday with our resident Nutrition Katie Thorp, who will provide three sessions. This Term, Katie will be partnering with Mrs Tricarico (our current Music

Teacher), who will also come in for three sessions. These Kitchen Garden sessions will complement one another and continue to provide our students with *hands-on learning opportunities in Nutrition, Gardening and Kitchen* over our final Term.

Please be reminded that the school has a **Report Writing Curriculum Day the day before the Melbourne Cup** Public Holiday this year. This will effectively create a Super Long Weekend although there will be care available through TheirCare if you require it on the Monday.
